

Need HELP paying for CHILD CARE?



“Working Connections” Child Care subsidies are now available!

As of December 14, 2011:

There is NO WAITLIST for Working Connections Child Care!

Washington State provides subsidies for low income families to help pay for child care.

Your family may be eligible for this program if:

1. *The child who needs subsidized care is a U.S. citizen or legal resident.*
2. *Your family lives in Washington State.*
3. *Your monthly family income is at or below 175% FPL. Check your income on the chart to the right to see if your income meets this requirement.*
